

Personal Manifesto/Vision for Work - Examples

1) Your relationship to your work

Vision: I will seek to develop in identified areas of growth.

Action: I will take a training course/read a book/etc and solicit feedback from my supervisor or co-workers regularly in this area of the course of this next year.

2) Your relationship to others at work

Vision: I Will look for ways to develop real friendships with co-workers

Action: I will eat lunch twice a week with co-workers.

OR

Vision: I Will seek to be a peacemaker at work

Action: I will be a "good gossip", spreading positive things about co-workers in the office

3) Your relationship to others' work

Vision: I will be a blessing others by helping them thrive and enjoy their work.

Action: I will design/find a quality of work assessment tool to determine how my employees/team/those who report to me are enjoying their work.

I will make it my intention to encourage/compliment others when they do good work.

4) Your work's relationship to God's Work

Vision: I Will Seek to bridge the sacred-secular divide in my own life.

Action: I will begin a practice of using the Daily Offices of Prayer to help me continually reconnect my work with God's work.

OR

Journal about issues that come up at work - use this as matters of prayer in private devotional time

OR

Bring up work-related issues in sermon discussion/community group discussions
